



FACTS AT A GLANCE

ATHLETICS

High school and middle school athletics are embraced by the community and events are often well-attended. Student athletes are expected to fulfill their academic responsibilities while participating in their respective sports and to be positive role models on campus and in the community.

Funding and Costs:

- The District does not receive any additional state funding for athletic programs.
- Currently \$184,279 general fund dollars are spent on athletics district-wide.
- Currently \$102,313 of these general fund dollars are spent at SVHS.
- Currently \$ 8,058 school site funds are spent on athletics at SVHS.
- \$117,971 is spent on coaching stipends
- \$ 78,200 is contributed by the Sonoma Valley High School Booster Club on an annual basis.
- \$46,617 is generated by ticket sales.
- \$44,136 is generated by team fundraising efforts.
- \$69,147 is generated by transportation fees (\$125 per sport). Scholarships are available as needed.

Additional Facts:

- Sonoma Valley High School sports: Varsity, and in some instances Junior-Varsity and Freshmen, team sports including football, cross-country, golf, soccer, baseball, softball, volleyball, basketball, wrestling, swimming, water polo, tennis, track and cheerleading.
- Approximately 632 students participate in athletics at the High School. This figure is not exclusive – a student is counted twice if he/she plays two sports.
- High School Student athletes must maintain a 2.0 GPA with no more than 1 “F”.
- Middle school sports, seventh and eighth grade: basketball, volleyball, track, wrestling, and soccer.
- Middle School Student athletes must maintain a 2.0 GPA and must be passing all classes.
- Approximately 160 – 180 students participate in athletics at each Middle School.
