SONOMA VALLEY HIGH SCHOOL **CAREER/VOCATIONAL/REGIONAL OCCUPATION PROGRAM** **EDUCATION**

Funding and Costs:

- Sonoma County Office of Education Regional Occupation Program (ROP) provides \$160,613 which covers the costs for 2.0 certificated FTEs.
- The County ROP additionally and directly employs 2.0 FTE instructors to work at SVHS.
- The District receives \$23,903 in Carl Perkins Vocational Education grant funds which are used to pay for materials.
- The District receives \$14,437 in Agriculture Vocational Education grant funds.
- A total contribution of \$268,641 is made from the general fund to pay for the remaining cost of vocational education/career related courses and associated expenses.
